

“Lord, whom shall we go away to? You have sayings of everlasting life; and we have believed and come to know that you are the holy one from God.” (John 6:68-69) Those words were directed by Peter to Jesus Christ himself. We can do the same today, by reading the Gospels over and over until we are familiar with Jesus's teachings. [(**Matthew 24:24, 25**)²⁴ For false Christs and false prophets will arise and will give great signs and wonders so as to mislead, if possible, even the chosen ones.²⁵ Look! I have forewarned YOU.] Have JW's taught you things in the past that proved not to be true, and yet still claim what *they* teach is spiritual food and demand you not question anything they say. [(**Deuteronomy 18:21, 22**)²¹ And in case you should say in your heart: “How shall we know the word that Jehovah has not spoken?”²² when the prophet speaks in the name of Jehovah and the word does not occur or come true, that is the word that Jehovah did not speak. With presumptuousness the prophet spoke it. You must not get frightened at him.’] When people teach what is not true and then correct it, that is not getting brighter light. That is correcting false teachings.
