Here is the fuller corrected set, with translations stated

Stay awake and watch

“Keep awake therefore, for you do not know on what day your Lord is coming.” — Matthew 24:42 (ESV)

“You also must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.” — Matthew 24:44 (ESV)

Be ready at all times

“Be ready for whatever comes, dressed for action and with your lamps lit, like servants waiting for their master to come back from a wedding feast, so that as soon as he comes and knocks, they will open the door to him.” — Luke 12:35–36 (Good News Bible)

“How happy are those servants whose master finds them awake and ready when he comes!” — Luke 12:37 (Good News Bible)

Do not grow spiritually asleep

“For you yourselves know very well that the day of יהוה will come like a thief in the night.” — 1 Thessalonians 5:2 (ESV, adjusted for יהוה)

“So then, we should not be sleeping like the others; we should be awake and sober.” — 1 Thessalonians 5:6 (God's Word Translation)

Live with expectation and hope

“As we wait for the blessed day we hope for, when the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ will appear.” — Titus 2:13 (Good News Bible)

Abide so as not to shrink back

“And now, dear children, remain united to Christ so that when he appears, we may be full of courage and not be ashamed before him on the Day he comes.” — 1 John 2:28 (Good News Bible)

Be patient and strengthen your heart

“Be patient, then, my friends, until the Lord comes. See how patient farmers are as they wait for the land to produce valuable crops. They wait patiently for the autumn and spring rains. You also must be

patient. Keep your hopes high, for the day of the Lord's coming is near.” — James 5:7–8 (Good News Bible)

Summary

These passages teach:

keep awake

be ready

remain watchful

stay faithful

keep hoping

endure patiently until Christ comes
